MINUTES: The minutes of the meeting of October 19, 2022 was approved on voice count. Director Ayerza motioned for approval and Director Pucheu seconded the motion.

TREASURER REPORT: The <u>Cash Flow</u> statement was presented for the month of October 2022 including the cash disbursements and receivables. Director Pucheu motioned for approval of the Treasurer report. Director Ayerza seconded the motion.

WATERMASTER'S REPORTS: Water use – irrigation and drinking water: Watermaster Rodney Wade reported on the usage totals for the month of October 2022, the well pumping totals and the Mendota pool reporting. The Well depths and the PH/TDS readings were presented to the Board. The flow meter readings were also presented. Horacio is working to get the treatment plant back online.

DIRECTOR REPORT: none

COUNSEL REPORT: In regards to legal matters affecting the District –<u>Leg Committee</u>: updates are coming. <u>Exchange Contractors</u>: They received a favorable outcome for the reservoir. <u>USBR</u>: they are reopening negotiations with the Exchange Contractors to discuss contract changes. Both sides will have to agree. <u>SGMA:</u> They are still waiting on the DWR review of the amended GSP. A response is expected end of 1st quarter 2023. They are currently working on a measurement policy – putting meters on all wells in the subbasin. We (TID) have everything metered and will be replacing some broken ones next year. It was suggested that we work up a meter calibrating schedule.

ENGINEERING CONSULTANT REPORT:

SGMA: The budget has been drafted. The Board took action to approve the Resolution 2022-04 to apply for grant funding for the Delta Mendota Subbasin. Director Pucheu motioned and Director Ayerza seconded the motion.

Projects: Lift 3 has been stalled. It is now officially an emergency. Meter project- this project is almost ready to go out to bid. New CW wells – The State has agreed to move forward with this project. Plans and Specs are being worked on for the new well sites.

MANAGER REPORT:

1. 2022 Critical Water Year Tracking: an updated plan was presented to the Board.

- 2. Motor Scraper/Delivery: the new unit will be coming in December with the 1st payment being made in January.
- 3. Water Rate/ 2023: The new well water rate needs to be \$200.00 per acre foot. This was already approved under Prop 218. We will start charging this new rate July 16th 2023.
- 4. TID/BBQ Lunch: the Lions Club will be helping with the luncheon this year.
