Chairman Pucheu called the meeting to order at 8:30 am.

MINUTES: The minutes of the meeting of November 16, 2022 was approved on voice count. Director Pucheu motioned for approval and Director Ayerza seconded the motion.

TREASURER REPORT: The <u>Cash Flow</u> statement was presented for the month of November 2022 including the cash disbursements and receivables. Director Pucheu motioned for approval of the Treasurer report. Director Ayerza seconded the motion.

WATERMASTER'S REPORTS: Water use – irrigation and drinking water: Watermaster Rodney Wade reported on the usage totals for the month of November 2022, the well pumping totals and the Mendota pool reporting. The Well depths and the PH/TDS readings were presented to the Board.

DIRECTOR REPORT: Director Pucheu reported on the SLDMWA meeting – its budget time. There was also discussion about the reallocation of fees among the participating districts.

COUNSEL REPORT: In regards to legal matters affecting the District – <u>KRWA:</u> hatchlings will be released in February. Some erosion is being cleaned up at Pine Flat Dam. <u>SGMA:</u> comments are expected from DWR by the end of 1st quarter 2023. Policies are being worked on requiring meters on wells this next year. The Board was asked to review and take action to extend the negotiation period for one year under the James ID & Tranquillity ID Agreement and authorize the execution of the letter of agreement. Director Pucheu made a motion for approval and Director Ayerza seconded the motion.

ENGINEERING CONSULTANT REPORT:

SGMA: there are two projects that have been submitted for the grant application. Data is being collected for the annual report due in April. Subsidence monitoring data should be available in January from USBR. Projects: all projects are stalled at the moment. A11 will be switching to electric but will have to use Well 4 until the switch is complete. This will take about two weeks. The site for CW 8 is secured and we are waiting on paperwork for the CW9 location. The lift 3 project is being tabled until next month.

MANAGER REPORT:

1. Resolution 2023-01 Approve budget, irrigation water rates, service fee rates: the budget was presented and after review the Board approved the budget. Director Pucheu made a motion for approval and Director Ayerza seconded the motion. The new well water rate of \$200.00 for the 2023 water year was

approved by the Board. Director Pucheu made a motion for approval and Director Ayerza seconded the motion.

- 2. 2022 Critical Water Year Tracking: an updated plan was presented to the Board.
- 3. Motor Scraper/Lease: waiting on Caterpillar for the lease agreement.
- 4. Water Rate/ 2023 Equipment Rental Rates: see item 1 above
- 5. DMC Subsidence Correction Project: SLDMWA will be shutting down the pool in January. The State is doing a subsidence study for the Lower DMC. Service should be restored by February 1, 2023.
- 6. SLWD Review Water Agreement: the contract is extended for two more years because of the 0% CVP allocation. The fee will stay the same.
