MINUTES: The minutes of the meeting of January 17, 2024 was approved on voice count. Director Ayerza motioned for approval and Director Pucheu seconded the motion.

TREASURER REPORT: The <u>Cash Flow</u> statement was presented for the month of January 2024 including the cash disbursements and receivables. Director Pucheu motioned for approval of the Treasurer report. Director Ayerza seconded the motion.

WATERMASTER'S REPORTS: Water use – irrigation and drinking water: Watermaster Wade reported on the usage totals for the month of January 2024, along with the well pumping totals and the Mendota pool reporting. The well depths along with PH/TDS readings were presented to the Board.

NEW BUSINESS/ACTION ITEMS:

A. Easement Agreement with Tranquillity Public Utilities District (sewer lift station) - tabled until next month

COUNSEL REPORT: In regards to legal matters affecting the District: <u>KRWA</u> – James ID settlement update: still waiting on 10 signatures. Water storage space looks good at Pine Flat. ACWA State Leg – AB828 amends SGMA by creating exemptions for small water systems allowing them to pump whatever they want – ACWA opposed. SGMA: see Engineering Consultant report

ENGINEERING CONSULTANT REPORT:

SGMA: they are currently moving forward with a single GSP. The 90-day notice will be going out soon. Exceedance thresholds are becoming an issue. When it happens, we will need to research what caused it. Some of it is out of our control due to neighbor well pumping. There will be monthly reporting requirements for metered wells.

Projects: Meter Project: completion of this project will be sometime in May. With regards a billing software – we have met with 2 companies but haven't chosen yet. Well 8: they are going to set it above the Corcoran clay. The water quality is like well 6 & 7. The well equipping portion will be out to bid soon.

MANAGER REPORT:

- 1. 2024 Water Schedule Tracking: updated report was presented
- 2. FID/KRWA Strategic Planning: FID reached out to discuss a potential TID & FID water program
- 3. 2024 Rights Water Request & Schedule: we submitted a revised water rights schedule and have received approval from USBR which allows us to move water forward to later in the year.

- 4. SLWD 2024 CVP Water: they have moved 10% of our 2023 CVP water forward. They plan to take whatever CVP water is available for the 2024 water year.
- 5. Oneill outage April 15 May 30th: they will be having another meeting to discuss actual water needs that we will have to cover on our own during this time period. They have to shut down to make necessary repairs.
